- There will be **four writing assignments (escrituras)**. Each *escritura* will have a first version and a final version. The first versions will be written in class on the dates indicated in this document. The final version is a rewrite of the first version, following the instructor's comments. The final versions are due at the beginning of class on the days specified in this document. The final versions must be typed, double-spaced, and printed with Arial 12- point font, 1" margins, and legible. If assignment format requirements are not met, there will be a 0.5-point deduction in the *escritura* grade. You **MUST** turn in the original (graded) first version with the rewrite in order to receive credit for it. See the policies for more information on *escrituras*. Each version of the *escrituras* will be returned to you, corrected and graded, one week after you turn it in.
